- Review of Health and Safety Committee meeting policy and format.
- **Security Camera Installation Update:** District-wide security camera installation progressing. YHS almost completed, with the MESMS to start next. Central monitoring location to be main offices/lobby areas. Web-based access to view security cameras available via the internet, with proper authority/clearance. TA’s/IA’s will be equipped with 9-1-1 call-out from main office/lobby locations.
- **Pandemic Flu Preparedness:** Hand-outs made available to all attendees. Purell and other disinfectants are more effective than soap & hot water. Pandemic sub-committee established (Rob, Charlie and Linda) to review planning checklists in the event of a pandemic influenza (see www.pandemicflu.gov/plan/schoolchecklist.html). Other pandemics such as SCARS, Avian Flu, West Nile, etc. discussed. Communication, web-postings, and investigative follow-up sought through sub-committee. Canadian goose droppings also to be researched by George.
- **Standard for Pre-Construction Postings:** Sample pre-construction document handed-out. Each building tasked to identify person(s) responsible for reporting any/all school building construction projects. Discussed more formal process to report any/all Health & Safety items through building principals. Committee to keep log for trend and response analysis.
- **Green Cleaning Update:** Dennis/George reported that all school districts are to be in compliance with new green cleaning legislation as of September 1, 2006. While this doesn’t mean disposal of existing materials and supplies currently being used for building cleaning, it does specify that products purchased after such date be considered off a pre-approved state listing (made available to all school districts on August 4, 2006). Each building head custodian was transmitted the entire list of state approved green cleaning products for their review. Recommendations and follow-up forthcoming.
