Circolo Da Vinci Scholarships:

1. **Academic Scholarship** – Senior student of Italian-American ancestry and must be planning to attend a formalized program in his/her prospective field. **Criteria:** High academic standing, school/community service and must interview with the scholarship committee. Recipient **must** attend scholarship dinner in May. **Deadline is March 26, 2010.** Application available in the Scholarship Binder in the Guidance Center.
2. **Vocational/Technical Scholarship** – Senior student of Italian-American ancestry and must be planning to attend a formalized program in his/her prospective field. **Criteria:** High academic standing, school/community service and must interview with the scholarship committee. Recipient **must** attend scholarship dinner in May. **Deadline is March 26, 2010.** Application available in the Scholarship Binder in the Guidance Center.
3. **Special Education** – Senior student of Italian-American ancestry and must be planning to attend a formalized program in his/her prospective field. **Criteria:** School/community service and must interview with the scholarship committee. Westchester and Putnam Counties Association of Town Superintendents of Highways, Inc. (WPCATSH) – Student must be accepted/enrolled in a vocational school, accredited college or university, intended major in the field of Public Works, Operations and/or Management including Highway Operations, Engineering and Environmental Studies, and be a resident of Westchester or Putnam County. Scholarships shall be awarded on the basis of merit, need and character. 2010 Miles of Hope Breast Cancer Foundation Scholarship – This scholarship is being offered to assist students who have been affected by breast cancer in some way.
